Course Objectives for N108 MEWP Boom

It is envisaged that at the end of the course the trainee operator will be able to answer questions on and perform the following:

- Have a basic understanding of the industry, the dangers of the industry & their responsibilities as a plant operator
- Have a working knowledge of the manufacturer handbook for the particular machine being used & be familiar with other information sources and the legislative requirements
- Be able to locate and identify the major components of the machine and explain their functions
- Be able to locate and identify steering, driving and braking controls & explain their functions
- Conduct all pre-operational checks in accordance with manufacturer and legislative requirements
- Check all emergency lowering functions
- Safely mount and dismount the machine
- Configure the machine for travel
- Configure the machine for travel and manoeuvre it on level/rough ground and inclines in level and confined spaces
- Conduct all necessary safety checks at the work area including overhead and underground hazards Manoeuvre the machine to the work area & correctly configure in readiness to carry out accessing tasks
- Carry out accessing tasks at various points up to full operating height
- Travel with platform raised (where applicable)
- Demonstrate knowledge and understanding of loading and unloading procedures for machine transportation
- Carry out all end of shift and shut down procedures
