



Course Objectives for N139 Forward Tipping Mini Dumper

It is envisaged that at the end of the course the trainee will be able to answer questions on and perform the following:

- Have a basic understanding of the industry, the dangers of the industry and their responsibilities as an operator
- Have a working knowledge of the manufacturer handbook of the particular machine being used
- Be able to locate and identify major components of the machine and explain their function
- Be able to locate and explain key controls and explain their function
- Conduct all pre-operative checks in accordance with manufacturer and legislative requirements
- Identify & maintain PPE appropriate for forward tipping mini dumper use
- Conduct all necessary checks in the work area
- Prepare the forwards tipping dumper for use and operate safely and efficiently
