Course Objectives for N106 Log Handler

It is envisaged that by the end of the training the trainee operator will be able to answer questions on and perform the following:

- Will have a basic understanding of the industry, the dangers of working in the industry and their responsibilities as an operator
- Have a working knowledge of the manufacturer handbook for the particular machine being used
- Be able to locate and identify major components of the machinery and explain their functions
- Be able to locate and identify steering, driving and braking controls & explain their functions
- Conduct all pre-operational checks in accordance with manufacturer and legislative requirements
- Safely mount and dismount the machine
- Safely start and stop the engine and move the machine off and stop it safely
- Configure the machine for travel and manoeuvre it safely across varying terrain in open and confined spaces
- Conduct all necessary safety checks in the work area
- Manoeuvre machine to the work area and correctly configure to carry out all tasks
- Carry out stacking/ de-stacking tasks
- Load and unload logs onto transporting vehicle
- Fit & remove attachments
- Demonstrate knowledge of loading and unloading procedures for machine transportation
- Carry out all end of shift & shut down procedures.
