



Course objectives for NOO4 Lorry Mounted Lift truck

It is envisaged that at the end of the training the trainee operator will be able to answer questions on and perform the following:

- Have a basic understanding of the industry, the dangers of working in the industry and their responsibilities as operators
- Have working knowledge of the manufacturer handbook of the particular machine being used
- Be able to locate and identify the major components of the machinery and explain their functions
- Be able to locate and identify steering, driving and braking controls and explain their functions
- Conduct all pre-operational checks in accordance with manufacturer and legislative requirements
- Safely mount and dismount the machine
- Start and stop the machine, move the machine off and stop it safely
- Configure the machine for travel and manoeuvre it safely laden and un-laden, in open and confined areas
- Conduct all necessary checks in the work area
- Manoeuvre the machine to the work area and correctly configure in order to carry out lifting and load handling tasks
- Carryout lifting and load handling tasks
- Lift and transfer loads accurately and safely at different locations
- Fit, adjust or remove attachments
- Demonstrate knowledge of loading and unloading procedures for machine transportation
- Carry out all end of shift and shut down procedures
