



Course Objectives for N017 Abrasive Wheels Handheld Cut-off Saw

It is envisaged that by the end of this course of training the learner will be able to answer questions on and perform the following:

- Have a basic understanding of the industry, the dangers of working in the industry & their responsibilities as an operator
- Have a working knowledge of the manufacturer's handbook and be familiar with other sources of information including relevant legislation
- Be able to locate and identify the major components of the machine and explain their functions
- Be able to locate and identify key controls and their functions
- Conduct all pre-operational checks in accordance with the manufacturers and the legislative requirements
- Identify & maintain PPE appropriate for petrol driven cut off saw
- Select suitable type of abrasive wheel & battery/petrol cut off saw relative to the work being undertaken
- Conduct all necessary safety checks at the work area & set up safety zone
- Prepare the machine for use & operate machinery safely & efficiently
- Environmental considerations
- Storage & transport of abrasive wheel & battery/ petrol cut off saws
- Carry out all end of shift & shut down procedures
