



### **Course Objectives for N036 Lift Truck Supervisor Awareness**

It is envisaged that by the end of the course the trainee operator will be able to answer questions on and perform the following:

- Have a basic understanding of the industry, the dangers of working in the industry and their responsibilities as a supervisor, selection of work equipment and procedures in order to work safely within the environment
- Have a basic understanding of a supervisor responsibilities and relevant legislation, policies and procedures including relevant risk assessments, method statements and traffic management systems
- Be able to supervise the work safely and identify various hazards including dangers within the environment.
- Have an underpinning knowledge of the manufacturer manual/ handbook for the equipment
- Be able to check certification for equipment & accessories including PPE.
- Correctly risk assess the task and implement a safe system of work, prepare a step-by-step method statement, including selection of equipment to be used
- Allocate team roles and responsibilities through a toolbox talk/ safety briefing
- Oversee tasks ensuring the team safely follows the step-by-step safe system of work
- Liaise with management and operators
- Deliver a de-brief meeting with the team and discuss any lessons learned during a specific task
