



Course Objectives for N035 MEWP Supervisor Awareness

It is envisaged that at the end of the course the trainee operator will be able to answer questions on and perform the following:

- Have a basic understanding of working at height equipment, the dangers of working at height, their responsibilities as a supervisor, selection of work equipment and procedures in order to work safely in the environment
- Have a basic understanding of a supervisor responsibilities and relevant legislation, policies and procedures including relevant risk assessments, method statement and traffic management systems
- Be able to supervise the work safely and identify various hazards including dangers of working at height and emergency rescue procedures
- Have an underpinning knowledge of the manufacturer handbook/ manual for the equipment
- Be able to check certification for equipment and accessories including PPE.
- Correctly risk assess the task and implement a safe system of work, prepare a step-by-step method statement including selection of equipment to be used.
- Allocate team roles and responsibilities through a toolbox talk/ safety briefing
- Oversee task ensuring team safely follows the step-by-step safe system of work
- Liaise with management and operators
- Deliver a de-brief meeting with the team and discuss any lessons learned during a specific task.
