Course Objectives for N133 Plant Machinery Marshall

It is envisaged that by the end of the course the learner will be able to answer questions on and perform the following:

- Have a basic understanding of the industry and the relevant legislation, the dangers of working in the industry and their responsibilities as a vehicle/plant machinery marshal
- Have knowledge of the manufacturer handbook of the particular machine /vehicle to be guided
- Have a good understanding of signs/signals, approved hand signals & different forms of communication
- Identify and maintain PPE appropriate for vehicle/ plant machinery marshal
- Conduct all necessary safety checks in the work area including stop blocks and tipping areas
- Set up exclusion zone for loading/unloading
- Guide machinery in a forward and reverse direction including confined spaces and “blind” area safely and efficiently
- Carry out all end of shift, shut down and parking procedures
