Course objectives for N135 Multi-directional Lift Truck

It is envisaged that by the end of the course the trainee operator will be able to answer questions on and perform the following:

- Have a basic understanding of the industry, the dangers of working in the industry and their responsibilities as operators
- Have a working knowledge of the manufacturer handbook for the particular machine to be used
- Be able to locate and identify major components of the machine and explain their function
- Conduct all pre-operational checks in accordance to the manufacturer and legislative requirements
- Safely mount and dismount the machine
- Start and stop the engine and safely move the machine off and stop it safely in each travel mode
- Configure the machine for travel and manoeuvre it safely laden and un-laden in open and confined areas in all travel modes
- Conduct all necessary safety checks in the work area
- Manoeuvre the machine to the work area and correctly configure in order to carry out lifting and load handling tasks using each travel mode as appropriate
- Carry out lifting and load handling tasks
- Lift and transfer loads accurately and safely at different locations
- Load and unload external transport safely
- Fit, adjust or remove attachments
- Demonstrate knowledge of loading and unloading procedures for machine transportation
- Carry out all end of shift and shut down procedures
