#### **Course Objectives for N109 MEWP Scissor Lift**

It is envisaged that at the end of the course the trainee operator will be able to answer questions on and perform the following:

- Have a basic understanding of the industry, the dangers of working in the industry and their responsibilities as a plant operator
- Have a working knowledge of the manufacturer handbook of the particular machine to be used, be familiar with other information sources & relevant legislation
- Be able to locate and identify the major components of the machine and explain their functions
- Be able to locate and identify steering, driving and braking controls & explain their function
- Conduct all pre-operational checks in accordance with manufacturer and legislative requirements
- Conduct all emergency lowering functions
- Safely mount and dismount the machine
- Configure the machine for travel
- Configure the machine for travel and manoeuvre it safely on level ground and on inclines in open and confined space
- Conduct all necessary safety checks at the work area including overhead and underground hazards
- Manoeuvre the machine to the work area & correctly configure in order to carry out accessing tasks
- Carry out accessing tasks at varying points up to full operating height
- Travel with platform raised (where applicable)
- Use platform raised where applicable
- Demonstrate knowledge & understanding of loading and unloading procedure for machine transportation
- Carry out all end of shift & shut down procedures
