



Course Objectives for N034 Plant Supervisor Awareness

It is envisaged that at the end of the course the trainee operator will be able to answer questions on and perform the following:

- Have a basic understanding of plant machinery/ equipment, the dangers of working in construction, their responsibilities as a supervisor, selection of equipment, procedures in order to work safely in the environment
- Have a basic understanding of a supervisor responsibilities and relevant legislation, policies and procedures including relevant risk assessments, method statement and traffic management systems
- Be able to supervise the work safely and identify various hazards including dangers of working in construction and emergency rescue procedures
- Have an underpinning knowledge of the manufacturer manual/ handbook for the equipment
- Be able to check certification for equipment & accessories including PPE.
- Correctly risk assess the task and implement a safe system of work, prepare a step-by-step method statement including selection of equipment to be used
- Allocate team roles and responsibilities through a toolbox talk/ safety briefing
- Oversee tasks ensuring the team safely follows the step-by-step safe system of work
- Liaise with management and operators
- Deliver a debrief meeting with the team including any lessons learned during a specific task
